

Doctoral study programs - Educational Psychology

Study demands

Total limit for proper completion of the study: 240 credits

Compulsory courses: 185 credits

Compulsory elective courses: 15 credits

The student chooses the remaining 40 credits at his / her discretion (eg other compulsory elective courses, re-enrollment in the subject Professional Communication in a peer-reviewed journal, International Internship or International Research, or brings eligible credits from a foreign internship).

The student can register for the state doctoral examination (SDE) after fulfilling all the obligations stated in the Individual study plan (ISP), after completing scientific seminars and other obligations set out in the ISP. SDE must be performed within one year after the end of the standard study time. The student registers for the SDE after the consent of the supervisor, resp. trainers-specialists, or faculty guarantor.

Further requirements

Students have a compulsory professional practice within the study; its targeting is suggested by the supervisor. Students complete the practice from the 2nd semester of study onwards. It can be implemented either in the form of participation in teaching at the Department in the range of max. 3 hours per week, or, if better suited to the dissertation project, the students can realize the practice at another institution, such as school, counseling institution, laboratory, etc. (where supervisor decides about the scope and the content of the internship).

The students are obliged to actively participate in the organization of professional activities of the Department, prepare and submit projects of GAJU. These duties aim at students' gaining the experience in project preparation, research management and at improving technical and financial conditions for solving the dissertation project.
