Zeny všech romských skupin nosily úrodnou...
bolem věrnosti – ostrihání vlasů bylo demonstrativním trestem pro nevěrnou...
ženy mívaly vlasy svázané do copu či uzlu a pokryté dozadu nebo na stranu vázaným
šátkem. Do vlasů si ženy a dívky rády vpletaly živé květy, ale i **mince**, ty si přišivaly
i na sukně, nosily je na řetězech a šňůrách kolem krku, hlavy, zápěstí, někdy i na kot-
nicích, mohly být kombinovány i s dalšími ozdobami, např. skleněnými korálky. Ženy,
na rozdíl od mužů, kteří se zdobili stříbrnými šperky, nosily častěji ozdoby zlaté.
